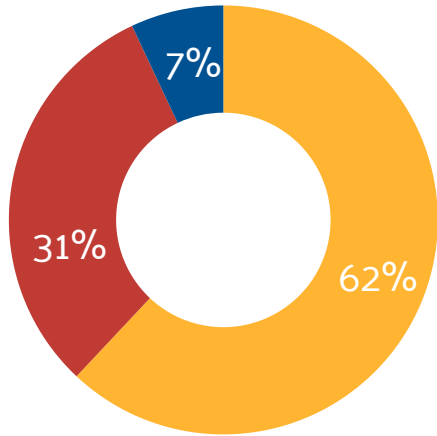




United for ALICE

ALICE is an acronym for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed – households that earn more than the Federal Poverty Level, but less than the basic cost of living for the county (the ALICE Threshold). They are working, but still struggling to keep up with the rising cost of inflation.



ALICE in Adams County

- Above ALICE Threshold - 62%
- ALICE - 31%
- Poverty - 7%

Comparing Adams County:
 State average ALICE Households (28%)
 State average Poverty Households (12%)

Income falls short of essentials



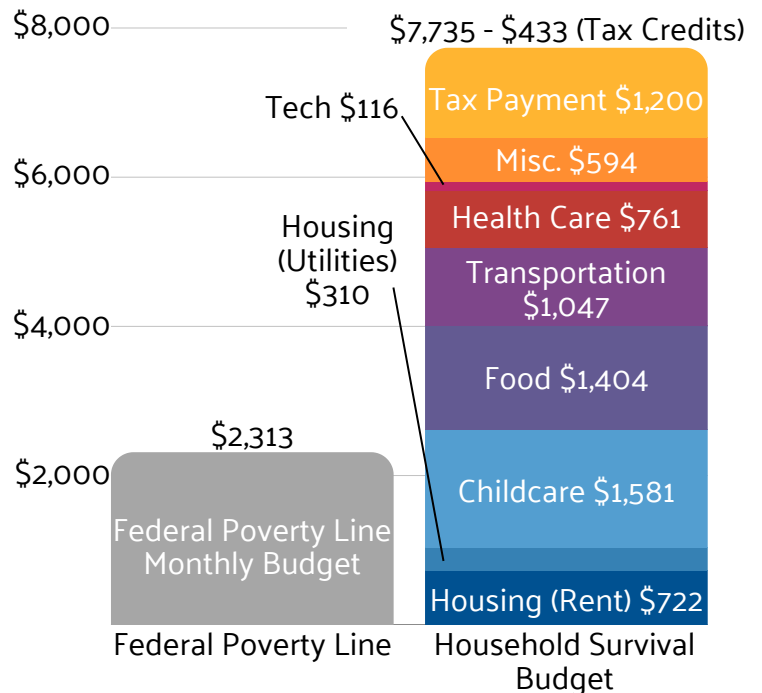
Employed

Household Survival Budget 2022

The ALICE survival budget is the bare minimum cost of living in our community. The example budget is for a family of four in Adams County. Those living on this budget are **one emergency away from slipping into poverty.**

\$7,302/month
for a family of four with two children in childcare

Roughly 1 in 3 households in Adams County are ALICE
